Volunteer Opening: Shower Facility Supervisor

Location: BCOC Opportunity Center, 721 Veterans Highway, Bristol PA

Dates/times: Mondays from 2 PM – 5 PM, beginning September 12th, 2022
Volunteers should plan to arrive at 1:45, participants arrive at approximately 2 pm.

Background: Bucks County Opportunity Council (BCOC) is partnering with Advocates for Homeless & Those in Need (AHTN) to provide shower facilities to community members experiencing homelessness. BCOC's shower facilities (one for men and one for women) at our Bristol Opportunity Center (721 Veterans Highway) will be used.

Volunteer Position: Shower Facility Supervisors will oversee the use of BCOC shower and laundry facilities between 2- 5 pm. Check-in participants when they arrive; provide toiletries to them for shower use (soap, shampoo, towels, etc.); Assist with laundry if needed; Manage logistics and flow of facility. This will be a weekly occurrence, based on need for facilities. We are seeking multiple volunteers for this position. BCOC coaches will be available on-site to provide other resources related to housing, clothing, jobs etc.

Requirements: PA Background Clearance, BCOC Volunteer Application, and a positive disposition!
