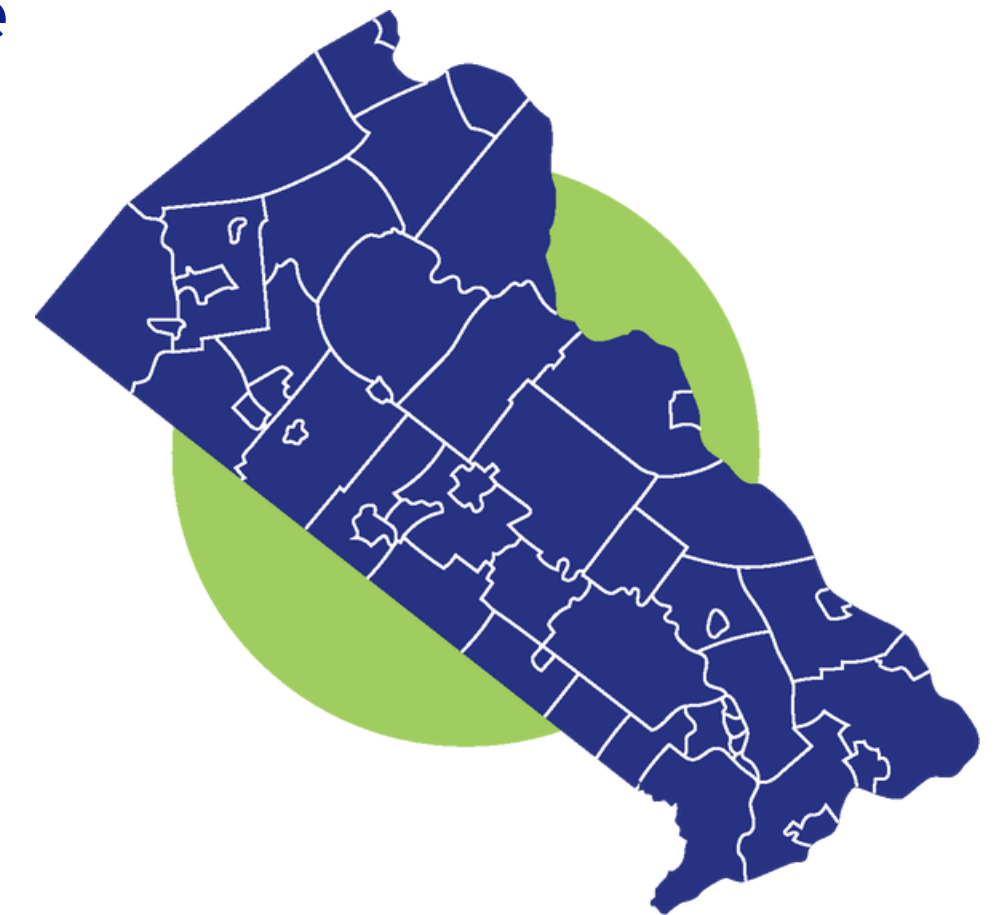

Housing and Emergency Services

 **395 Households** prevented from eviction

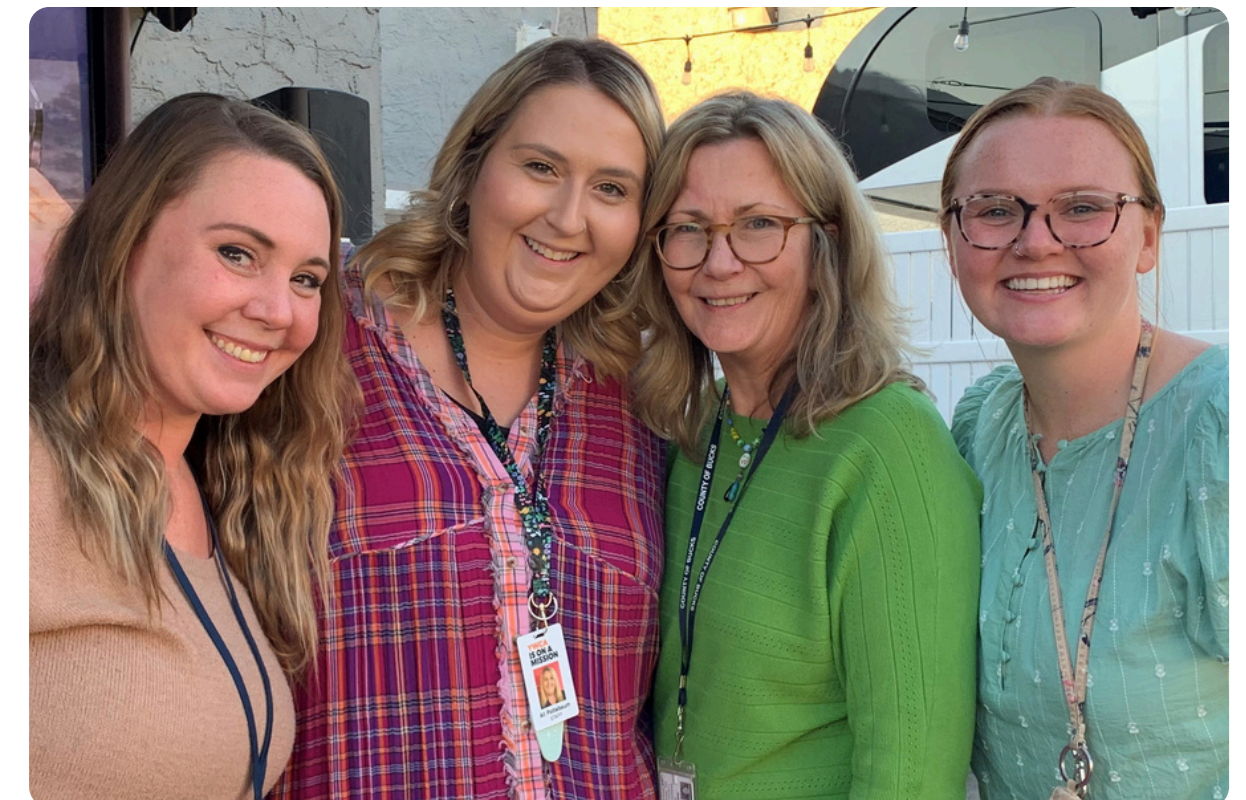

 **349 Households** were assisted with energy-saving measures

 **Energy Bills** were reduced, which increased home comfort

 **Environmental** benefits and long-term savings for families

 **\$372** average family savings per year
