## FREE FOOD FOR SENIORS

### Commodity Supplemental Food Program – PA Senior Food Box Program

#### What do you need to know to be eligible?

If you are 60 years of age or older. If your total household income is at/below 150% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines

#### What will you receive in the Food Box?

Fruits & Juices, Vegetables, Cheese (2lb block), Milk, Meat, Poultry, Fish, Plant-Based Protein, Cereals, Pasta, & Rice

*\*USDA Foods are shelf-stable and do not need refrigerated except for the cheese.*

*\*USDA Foods are packed according to USDA Food Package Rates*

#### What information will you need at the time of application?

**Verification of Identification** – include Date of Birth/Current Address

**NOTE:** If you have additional household members, you will need to list their names and monthly income.
